What is the Biotech A2M Scholars Program?

The **Biotech Associate to Master's (A2M) Scholars Program** is a scholarship program for biotechnology students. It's made possible through a National Science Foundation (NSF) grant awarded to Northeastern University and Middlesex Community College. The grant provides qualifying students with scholarships of up to \$10,000 per student, per year from their associate, bachelor's, and master's degree in biotechnology.

Along with financial assistance, textbooks, computers and transportation costs, the program also provides students like you with personalized support. This includes an A2M biotech navigator, tutoring, and a course roadmap to prepare for academic success and careers in biotechnology.

Benefits of Biotech A2M Scholars Program

- » Scholarships of up to \$10,000 per student, per year
- » Dedicated A2M support team to help you every step of the way
- » Supplied laptops and textbooks—at no cost—as well as assistance with transportation and tutoring costs, if you qualify
- » Pathway to Northeastern's accelerated PlusOne Master's degree program in biotechnology (up to 16 credits count toward a B.S. and M.S. at no additional cost)
- » B.S. and M.S. from top-ranked university
- » Increased lifetime earning potential from advanced degrees—60% higher earning potential with a M.S. vs. A.S.

AM I ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

To be eligible for the **Biotech A2M Scholars Program**, you must meet the following requirements:

Enrolled

Registered in a qualifying biotechnology degree program

Financial Need

Demonstrated financial need per FAFSA application or Pell Grant eligibility

Full-time

Minimum 12 credits each semester

2.5 GPA

Minimum for A.S. and B.S. students **or**

3.0 GPA

Minimum for M.S. students

Citizenship

U.S. Citizens, permanent residents, refugees (section 207)

Please note: Eligibility will be reviewed semi-annually to ensure that students continue to meet the criteria listed above.
