APPLICATION PROCESS

The Master of Science in Speech-Language Pathology program at the MGH Institute of Health Professions participates in CSDCAS, the Communication Science and Disorders Centralized Application Service. All students are required to apply through CSDCAS.

Items to submit directly to CSDCAS:

- CSDCAS Application with application fee
- Official transcript(s) from all colleges/universities attended
- Three (3) recommendation letters
- Statement of Intent
- MGH Institute Custom Questions

PREREQUISITES

Admission into the MS-SLP program requires a bachelor's degree from an accredited US college or university and the following prerequisite coursework:

MGH Institute MS in Speech-Language Pathology Prerequisites:

- Introduction to Communication Disorders
- Phonetic Transcription and Introduction to Acoustic Phonetics
- Anatomy and Physiology of Speech and Hearing Mechanisms
- Speech-Language Acquisition
- Audiology (not Hearing Science)

American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) Prerequisites:

- A Biological Science Course (no lab)
- A Social Science Course
- A Physical Science Course (Physics or Chemistry are acceptable) (no lab)
- A Statistics Course

ADDITIONAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

TOEFL/IELTS - Applicants whose first language is not English must provide test scores from either the [TOEFL](#) (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or the [IELTS](#) (International English Language Testing System). The test must have been taken within two years of the application deadline and official score reports are required.

Minimum TOEFL (internet-based) requirement is 89 and the minimum IELTS requirement is 6.5.

FOREIGN TRANSCRIPTS

Applicants that have earned a degree from a non-US institution are required to submit a course-by-course credential evaluation from one of the following NACES (National Association of Credential Evaluation Services) members: Educational Credential Evaluators, Inc., SpanTran: The Evaluation Company, World Education Services (WES), or the Center for Educational Documentation. If you earned your bachelor's degree outside the U.S. this credential evaluation must document minimum equivalency of a US baccalaureate degree or higher.

FINANCIAL AID

A limited number of competitive scholarships are available; applicants are automatically considered upon acceptance. In addition, the Institute offers graduate assistantships and participates in federal and private loan programs. We encourage applicants to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (www.fafsa.gov) and to explore external resources.
