Q: How do I know what courses I need to take in order to apply to a specific program at the IHP, e.g., nursing, physician assistant studies, etc.?

A: For our graduate programs, we have created a comprehensive chart (see below) of courses we require prior to students matriculating into our programs.

- Each program's requirements are different and *things are always subject to change*, so it's best to check with each program about their specific prerequisites. A good place to start is here: <u>mghihp.edu/academic-programs.</u>
- ALWAYS check with every school to which you are applying about *their* requirements, as prerequisites can differ from school to school.
- Online courses and labs are accepted at MGH IHP, but not by every college. Check with schools to which you are applying about their lab requirements.
