

Doctor of Nursing Practice Program

BSN to DNP has two pathways for the Registered Nurse to enter: The BSN to DNP is for nurses with a Baccalaureate degree in Nursing and the Pre-Graduate Option PGO to DNP is for RNs with a non-nursing Baccalaureate degree. This degree prepares the graduate as an advanced practice registered nurse (nurse practitioner).

Post Master's to DNP (Online/hybrid) is for individuals who hold a Master's degree in nursing and are certified as NPs, CNSs, CRNAs, or CNMs or hold a Master's degree in nursing or a health related field and are in nursing leadership positions.

Nursing and Interprofessional Leadership Master in Science Program

The Master of Science program is an advanced nursing practice specialty in Interprofessional Leadership. The program prepares nurses as leaders who effectively promote health and care delivery through interprofessional, collaborative partnerships across academic, clinical practice, and social entities to transform the health care experience for best health outcomes for the patient, family and community-population. Graduates are prepared to assume diverse positions in hospitals, community organizations and agencies, business-related industries, and regulatory entities.

Graduate Entry Pathway

The Graduate Entry Pathway to DNP (GEP) is for individuals with a Baccalaureate degree in a field other than nursing, leading first to Registered Nurse (RN) licensure, then to Doctor of Nursing Practice (**nurse practitioner**) or PhD in Nursing (**nurse scientist**).

PhD Program

Four Pathways to PhD in Nursing: the focus of the PhD program is on the development and transformation of scholars who will lead the discipline of nursing.
