APPLICATION PROCESS

The Master of Science in Speech-Language Pathology program at the MGH Institute of Health Professions participates in CSDCAS, the Communication Science and Disorders Centralized Application Service. All students are required to apply through CSDCAS.

- Official transcript(s) from all colleges/universities attended
- Three (3) recommendation letters
- · Statement of Intent

PREREQUISITES

Admission into the MS-SLP program requires a bachelor's degree from an accredited US college or university and the following prerequisite coursework:

- Introduction to Communication Disorders
- Phonetic Transcription and Introduction to Acoustic Phonetics
- Anatomy and Physiology of Speech and Hearing Mechanisms
- Speech-Language Acquisition
- Audiology (not Hearing Science)

American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) Prerequisites:

- A Biological Science Course (no lab)
- A Social Science Course
- A Physical Science Course (Physics or Chemistry are acceptable) (no lab)
- A Statistics Course

ADDITIONAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

TOEFL/IELTS - The language of instruction and clinical education at the MGH Institute is English and a high level of proficiency in both written and spoken English is required. Applicants who have not completed either an undergraduate or graduate program where English is the language of instruction must demonstrate English Language proficiency as part of your application to the MGH Institute of Health Professions.

The IHP accepts either the TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or the IELTS (International English Language Testing System). The test must have been taken within two years of the application deadline and official score reports are required. The minimum TOEFL (internet-based) score accepted is 89 and the minimum IELTS score accepted is 6.5.

FINANCIAL AID

A limited number of competitive scholarships are available; applicants are automatically considered upon acceptance.
