NIH PREP (Post-baccalaureate Research Education Program) at UMass-Amherst is seeking applicants. Admissions are rolling for the 2023-2024 cohort. PREP is an NIH-funded post-baccalaureate training program that prepares students with a bachelor's degree in the physical or life sciences for doctoral study in the biomedical and biobehavioral sciences. To be eligible, applicants must be US citizens or Permanent Residents and have completed their undergraduate studies no more than 36 months prior to matriculation into the PREP.
